Main Presentation:

Jock presented his Line and Berry Inlay project. First he discussed the different tools available to cut the groove needed for the inlay. Veritas and Lee Valley both have hand tools available to cut straight grooves and arcs. A router can also be used but visibility and control was a bit of an issue. He finally settled on using the dremel tool in the Veritas Plunge base. This setup allowed for straight cuts as well as curves with the various attachments and accessories. Simple drill bits and dowels were used for the Berry sections.

Next he showed the various designs and patterns he tried before coming up with the final design for the project.

The presentation ended with a demonstration cutting some grooves with the dremel tool and the base.
